



BREW BAR

Boil Kettle (left): Wort (the liquid extracted from grains) is transferred here from the neighboring kettle. Hops are added during this stage to impart bitterness and flavor.

Mash Tun: Crushed grains are infused with hot water (150 degrees) to extract sugars. This sugary liquid, called wort, is then transferred to the boil kettle.

Water Room - Behind the Brew Bar

Left – This is a HLT (Hot liquor tank) It Provides the considerable hot water it takes for the entire brewing process.

Right – This holds the water for the reverse osmosis process.

Brew House Antique Alert!

The stained-glass window, visible from both the Brew House side and the Fermentation Room side, is the second oldest artifact here, surpassed only by the Gaper. In the mid-1920s, when the pipe organ was installed, the exterior wall housing this window was framed in and covered, likely preserving it. This window is the only remaining one from that era.



The two sides of the window are distinct. The yellow side and top are original to the 1898 building, while the other side features stenciled glass from the church that stood here in 1840. When the current structure was built in 1898, the old church was removed. This window predates the Civil War, adding a layer of historical significance to our venue.
